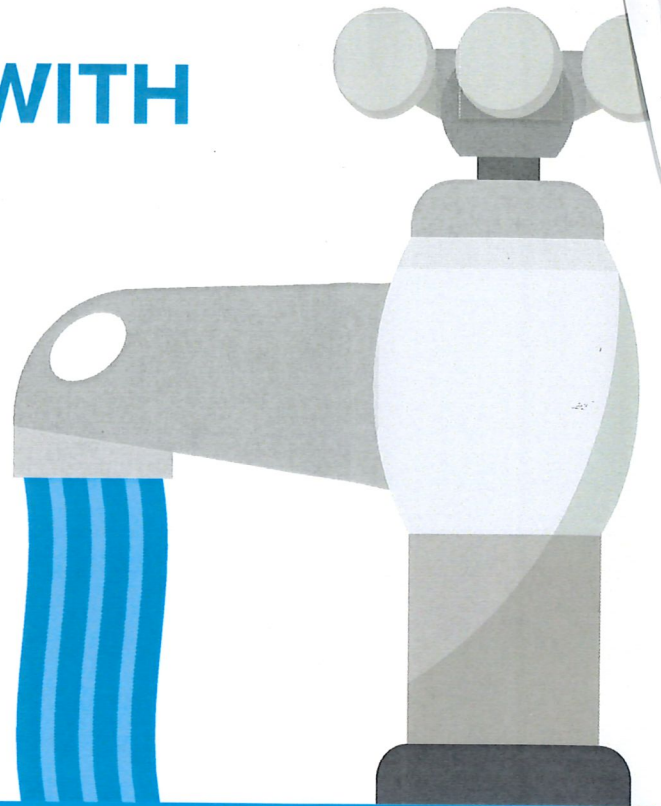


NEED ASSISTANCE WITH YOUR WATER BILL?

WRAP CAN HELP!

The Water Residential Assistance Program provides funding to eligible, low-income households. Funding is provided by the Great Lakes Water Authority and is administered in partnership with local community action agencies.



WRAP can help reduce your water bill and pay past due balances!

WRAP Eligibility:

- Reside within an eligible GLWA Member Community (Flint residents are eligible)
- Responsible for paying your water bill
- At or below 200% of the federal poverty level
- Own or rent your home

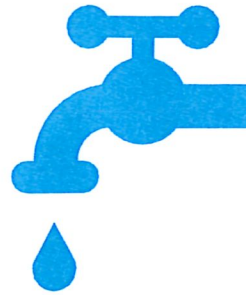

Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)



Every Drop Counts

Program Overview

The Low-Income Housing Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is a temporary emergency relief program to help low income households pay overdue water and wastewater bills. State of Michigan received funds from Congress to administer this program. This program is available to low-income homeowners and renters.

Allowable Services

Direct past due Water Bill Assistance for household accounts in arrears or disconnect status, including reconnect fees when services have been disconnected.

Eligibility Requirements

Qualified water account bill holders **MUST**:

- Be a residential account holder
- Be in arrears or disconnect status
- Be under 150% of Federal Poverty Level and/or actively receiving Family Independence Program/Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (FIP/TANF), Food Assistance Program/Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (FAP/SNAP), State Emergency Relief (SER), Social Security Supplemental Income (SSI).
