Information such as we will continue to enforce our ordinances such as NOISE, LOITERING, CURFEW, PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, ABANDON INOPERATIVE VEHI-CLES, etc. The Charter Township of Royal Oak prohibited the ownership of Pit Bulls and Pit Bull Terriers. THESE DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TOWNSHIP. An ordinance was passed in March 2008 prohibiting this dog. ALL OTHER

DOGS MUST BE LICENSED IN THE TOWNSHIP. Contact the Treasurers Office for further information. The Housing Commission will allow certain type of dogs only for seniors or persons with a disability to be used as companions. 
To the Citizens of the Charter Township of Royal Oak:
